-The medium of artworks are not restricted, but the height should not exceed 6 1/2 feet in order to accommodate the gallery.

-The images should be the works which is available for the show.

+ The materials will be reviewed by jurors in **November**

+ The finalists will be announced in early —on the website of Korean Cultural Service NY, followed by exhibition schedules

+ For the group exhibitions for the finalists, Gallery Korea will provide press release, printed invitations and opening reception, whereas the selected artists will be responsible for any other incurring costs including handling, shipping and installing artworks.
