WHO IS ELIGIBLE?

This is open to all artist, individual or group. Selected artists will have the opportunity to be featured in one of the group shows in 2008.

IS THERE A FEE TO ENTER?

None

HOW DO I ENTER?

- Individual
 1. Application Form
 2. Resume
 3. Artist's Statement
 4. 5 to 10 Slides (35mm slides with mount) or CD
 5. Description of each work
- Group
 1. Same materials as above for individual artist
 2. Exhibition Proposal
 3. Resume of the organizer
- Rules

Any medium is acceptable, but artworks may be two or three-dimensional, height of the works cannot exceed 6 1/2 feet high.
Minimum 5 up to 10 slides of your works can be submitted and the artist's name, title, year, medium and dimensions should be on each slide.

WHEN IS THE DEADLINE?

All materials should arrived by August, 31, or be postmarked by August 31, 2007.

WHEN WILL THE SELECTED ARTISTS BE ANNOUNCED?

Exact date will be announced on our website through September 2007 and selected artists will be notified via emails and regular mails.

CAN I GET MY MATERIALS BACK?

Submitted materials will be returned to the senders, if you include SASE.

WHAT IS GALLERY KOREA RESPONSIBLE FOR?
